- Autism/ADHD
- Migrant Farmworker Families
- Cancer
- Diabetes
- Asthma
- HIV/AIDS
- Other Chronic/Autoimmune Conditions
- Pregnancy
- Special Needs/Disability
- Emergency Room Visit for a Dental Issue
